Beard Track: Beard will prepare young Scouts for Leadership. They will work with learning the basics of troop/patrol leadership while practicing their Woodsman and Cooking Skills.
REQUIREMENTS: min. Second Class, Earned Totin' Chip and Fire'n Chit

Seton Track: Seton will prepare Scouts who have had limited leadership experience for a more active role in their troop. They will learn how to be an effective leader using the Patrol Method and beginning conflict resolution. Scouts completing this trek will also receive BSA ILST certification (Select 1 AM and 1 PM elective)
REQUIREMENTS: min. First Class w/ limited leadership skills

Baden-Powell: Baden-Powell will help older Scouts become stronger leaders and help them to reach even higher when setting goals. They will utilize advanced leadership skills to learn how to run a high performance Troop, how to conduct troop program planning for their unit and district. (Select 1 AM and 1 PM elective)
REQUIREMENTS: min. Life Scout

Monaken: Monaken will help Lodge members to learn Advanced Leadership skills while learning how to better serve as a leader in the OA. (Select 1 AM and 1 PM elective)
REQUIREMENTS: Monaken Lodge Member in Good Standing, must be approved by Lodge

Rover (Adults Only): Rover will allow adults to broaden their leadership skills and knowledge and delivery of the Boy Scout Program. Youth Protection Training will also be offered. For an additional fee CPR certification can be taken Friday night.
